TEL saves the schools and libraries of Tennessee \$94,445,493:

◆ \$23,357 for each elementary school.



◆ \$44,777 for each high school



\$124,697 for each college



\$133,518 for each public library

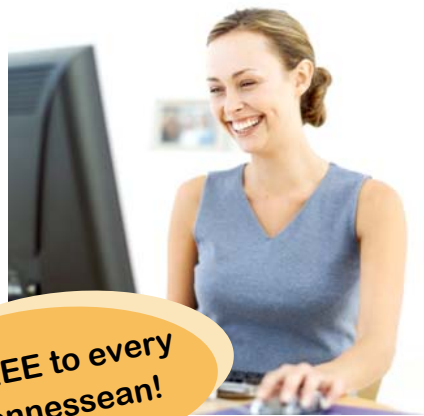
